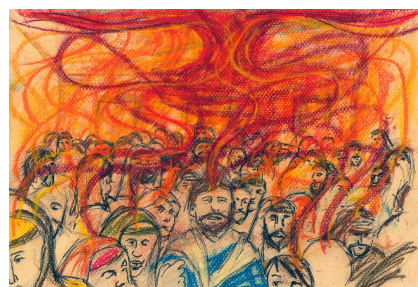

Acts 9.1-6 *Paul is converted on the Damascus Road and is baptized by Ananias.*

Revelation 5.11-14 *John's vision, angels blessing the Lamb of God.*

John 21.1-19 *Further interaction with the Risen Christ who commissions Peter and warns him of martyrdom.*

Acts 16.9-15 *Paul is called to Northern Greece to continue his Gentile mission. Lydia is converted.*

Revelation 21.10, 22-22.5 *A vision of the new Jerusalem from heaven and the water of life.*

John 14.23-29 *In his Farewell Discourses Jesus promises us the gift of his Spirit, the Paraclete or Comforter/Advocate.*

Sunday 29th May Easter 7

Acts 16.16-34 *Paul in Corinth. Imprisoned and escapes (cf. Peter in Acts 12).*

Revelation 22 *Jesus is coming soon.*

John 17.20-26 *Jesus prays for future disciples, including us – that we may be in him and see his risen glory, so that the love of the Father to the Son may embrace us too.*
